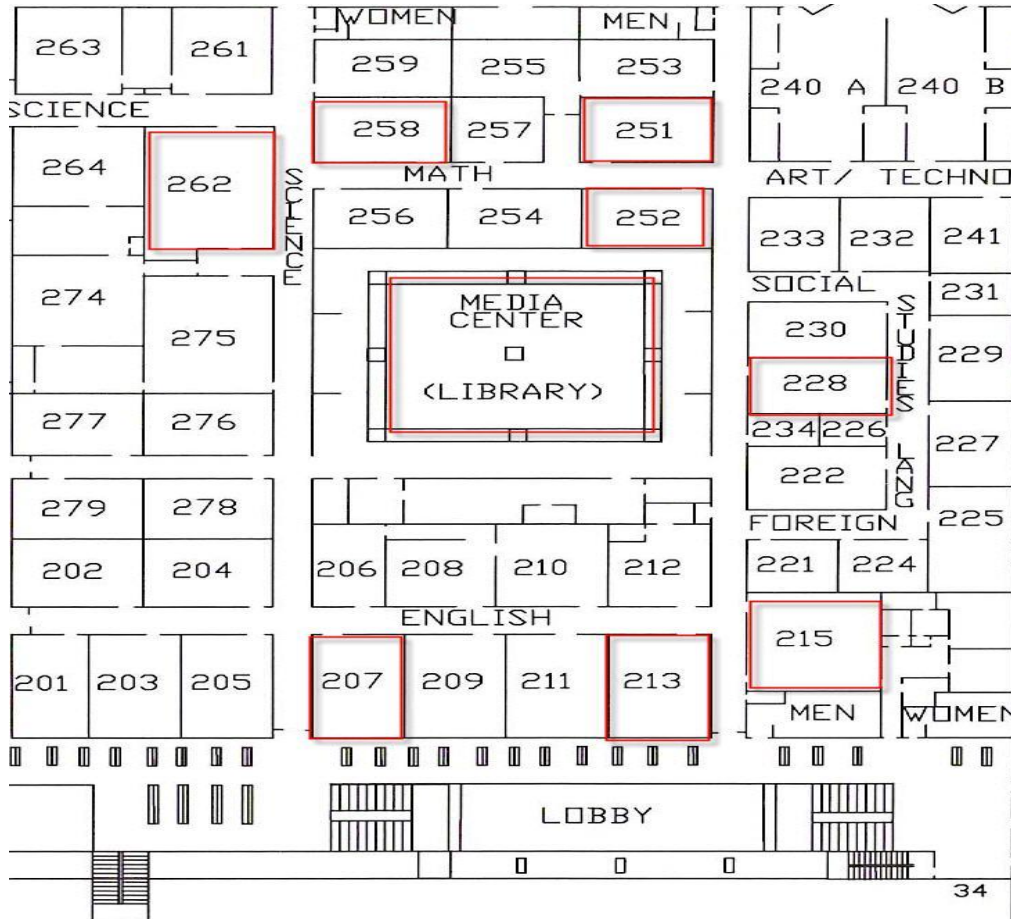

VoiceThreads & Animoto - Looking for a unique and fun way to combine your images and tell a story? These easy to use tools will help you create a multimedia experience with your images.

People can leave comments using voice (with a microphone or phone), text, audio file, or video (via a webcam).
- **Animoto** - <http://animoto.com/> - Combines your images and music to produce an MTV-style video with the click of a button.

Google Earth – <http://earth.google.com/> - Google Earth lets you fly anywhere on earth to view satellite imagery, maps, terrain, 3D buildings and even explore galaxies in the sky. You can explore rich geographical content, save your toured places and share with others. It can also be used to help your students understand the location of places studied in your curriculum.

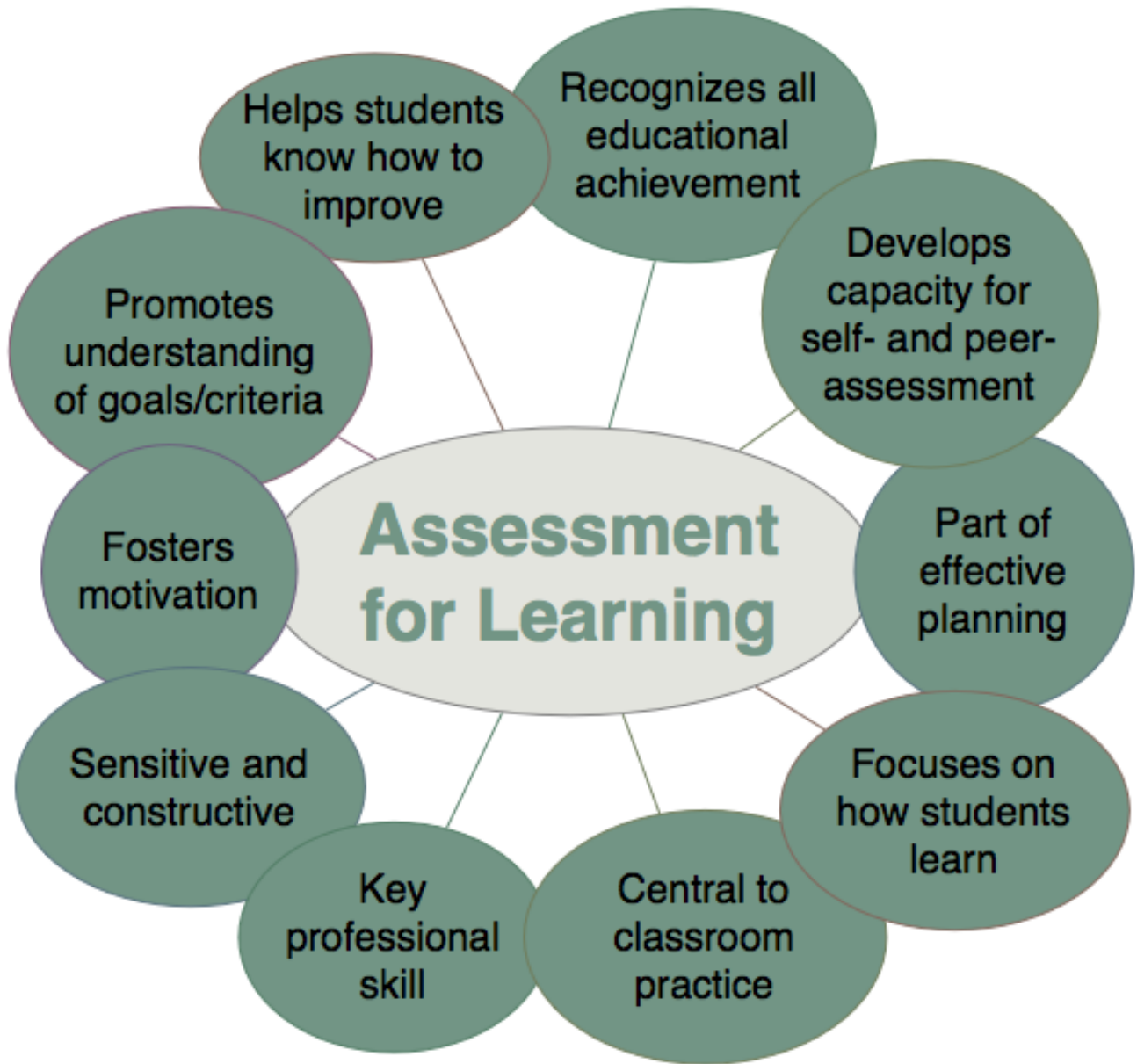
