MAKE-UP DAYS

There are a total of 9 possible make-up days in the 2008-09 calendar.

Of the nine, two are days built into the 2008-09 school calendar for make-up purposes only: February 27 and April 10, if either of the built in make-up days not used for make-up they will be designated as non-school days.

Seven additional days have been scheduled as possible make-up days. They are listed below in the planned order of their use. Students, parents, and employees should note that circumstances sometimes require a departure from the order listed. The order in which these days are used may change depending on the need to make-up days.

1. January 19 Rescheduled as a student day, Teacher Work Day on January 24
2. February 9 Parent/Teacher conferences rescheduled by the schools before and after regular contract hours.
3. February 27 No rescheduling needed, built in make-up day
4. April 10 No rescheduling needed, built in make-up day
5. April 17 Rescheduled as a student day
6. April 16 Rescheduled as a student day
7. April 15 Rescheduled as a student day
8. April 14 Rescheduled as a student day
9. March 20 Rescheduled as a student day, in-service day on March 21

CONTRACT SUMMARIES

Ten-month teaching personnel work 180 student days, 11 scheduled service days, 1 unscheduled service day, and receive eight paid holidays.

Ten and one half-month personnel work all work days and receive all holidays as ten-month personnel plus ten additional workdays as scheduled by the Superintendent or his designee.

Eleven-month personnel work all workdays and receive all holidays as ten-month personnel plus twenty additional workdays as scheduled by the Superintendent or his designee.

Twelve month personnel receive vacation, all teacher holidays and the additional holidays of July 4, December 22, 23, 26, 29, 30, 31 and January 2. All other days including non-school days are workdays for twelve-month personnel.

The two-hour early dismissals on August 29, November 26 and December 19 apply to all staff and students. Other early dismissals apply only to students.
