



1. China
 -E'peans created spheres of influence
 -Boxers revolted to kick out E'peans
 -called Boxer Rebellion (1900)
 -E'peans win

2. Japan
 -Japan had been isolationist
 -Commodore Perry (US) opens them to trade
 -Japan industrializes --powerful

3. Egypt (Suez Canal)

-French built Suez Canal in Egypt (trade easier)
 -connected Mediterranean & Red Seas
 -Egypt--*protectorate* of Britain

4. India

-East India Company dominated India
 -Britain takes over India (colony)

Q: If Indians don't want to be ruled by someone else, but instead want their own country to grow in strength, what cause of revolutions is this?

-Indian nationalism begins
 -Indian National Congress

5. Russo-Japanese War--1905

-Russia & Japan want Korea & Manchuria (China)

-Japan wins

6. Vietnam/Cambodia

-French colony (called Indochina)
