MAKE-UP DAYS 2019-2020

There are a total of 10 possible make-up days in the 2018-20 calendar, four excess time days and six makeup days. The days are listed in the planned order of their use. Students, parents, and employees should note that circumstances sometimes require a departure for the order listed. The order in which these days are used may change.

5. February 3 Rescheduled as a student day (Schedule conferences as needed)
6. March 20 Rescheduled as a student day

9. April 15 Rescheduled as a student day
10. April 14 Rescheduled as a student day

Depending on the timing and frequency of any missed days, specifically if an inordinate number of student days are missed early in the winter season, the Board may consider rescheduling the Rev. Martin Luther King Jr. and/or Memorial Day Holidays as additional student days to be determined no later than the January 8, 2019 and May 7, 2019 Board Meetings, respectively.

CONTRACT SUMMARIES Ten-month teaching personnel: work 180 student days, 9 scheduled service days, 2 conference days and receive nine paid holidays. Ten and one half-month personnel: work the same schedule as 10-month teaching personnel outlined above, plus ten additional workdays as scheduled by the Superintendent or his designee. Eleven-month personnel: work the same schedule as 10-month teaching personnel outlined above plus twenty additional days scheduled by the Superintendent or his designee. Twelve month personnel: receive vacation, all teacher holidays and the additional holiday of July 4 and the non-student days associated with Winter Break. All other days including non-school days are workdays. The two-hour early dismissals on August 30 and November 27 apply to all personnel. The other early dismissals apply to students only. Refer to School Board Policy GAA-SR STAFF TIME SCHEDULES AND UNSCHEDULED EARLY DISMISSALS for staff schedules and procedures on these days. There are three Flexible Teacher Workdays listed on the calendar. Ten-month, Ten-and one half-month and Eleven month personnel must pick one of these days to work.
